

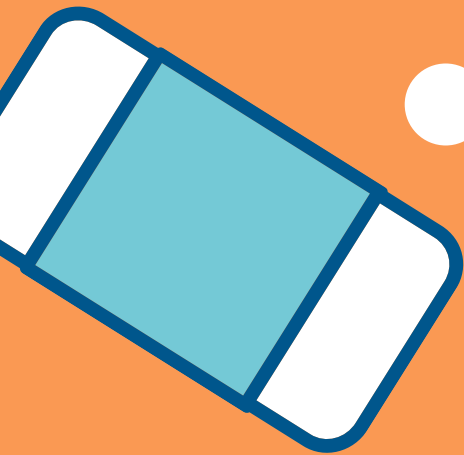

Total Registrants: 147

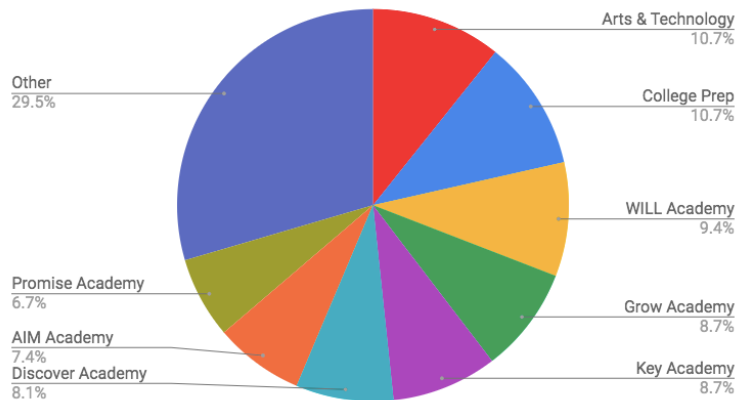
Registered for 2+ Sessions: 89%

REGISTRATIONS BY SCHOOL

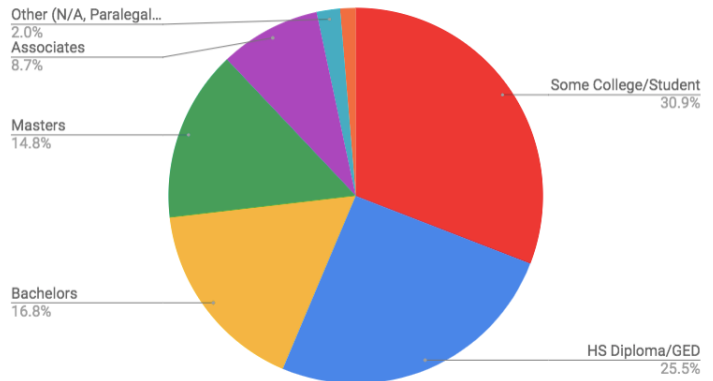

Participant Registrations by Education Level

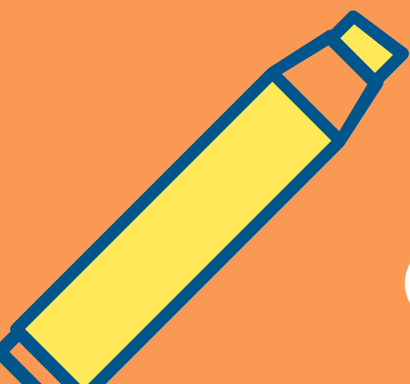


KEY FINDINGS

- There was at least 1 registrant from every KIPP DC school.
- 50% of KIPP DC schools registered at least 10 parents.
- FES received between 5 and 10 individual follow-up emails after each session.

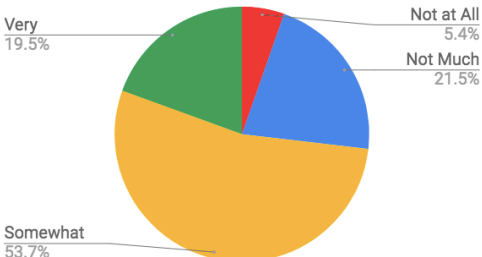

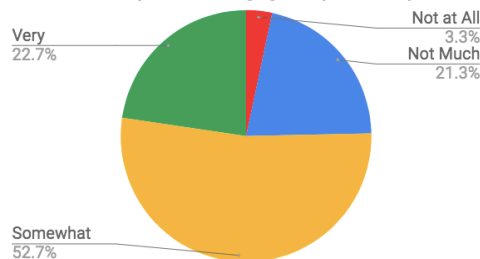
How familiar are you with 1) financial literacy, 2) managing family and money, 3) entrepreneurship, and 4) real estate investing?

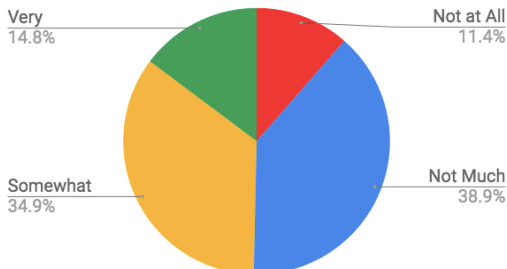
How familiar are you with Financial Literacy?



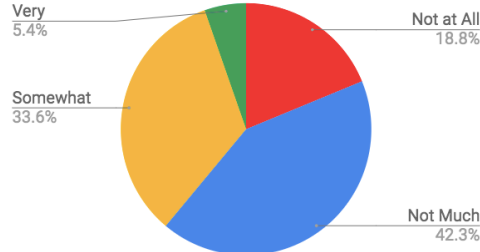
How familiar are you with Managing Family and Money?

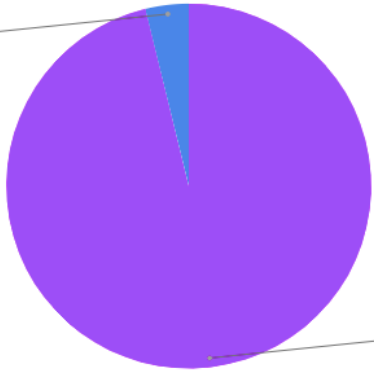
KEY FINDINGS

- Order of sessions proved to be appropriate and beneficial for participant growth over the course of the series.
- Despite nearly 75% of registrants initial thoughts on their familiarity and comfortability with the Session #2 topic: Managing Family and Money, this session garnered the most discussions and follow up questions.
- Participants are interested in learning more about how to manage their relationship with their children and money.

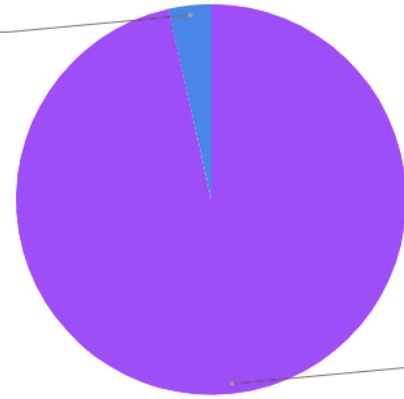

KEY FINDINGS

The following are specific session topics participants found most beneficial:

- Session #1: Budgeting
- Session #2: Budgeting (for children)
- Session #3: Starting a Business/LLC
- Session #4: Budgeting (for investments)

Additional Notes:

- 28 post surveys were submitted (18.9%)
- Over 95% of those surveyed responded "yes" when asked if they gained helpful knowledge.
- Over 95% of those surveyed responded "yes" when asked if they would join the next session.



FES RECOMMENDATIONS

01

Create a workshop series focused solely on parents/guardians and financial literacy education for students.

02

Offer in-person workshops to engage with parents/guardians using hands-on activities.

03

Create KIPP DC branded budgeting documents and hand-outs for parents/guardians.
